

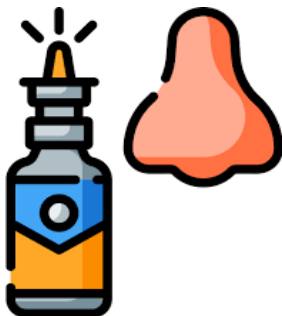
Northamptonshire School Aged Immunisation Service
