In the interest of hygiene, we ask all swimmers to shower prior to swimming.

You are requested not to swim for 14 days following sickness or diarrhoea. Inform a lifeguard if you have any medical conditions.

Babies/Toddlers must wear protective nappies in the water. These are available to purchase from reception.

Under 8s Swimming Policy: 1 adult can supervise up to 2 children under the age of 8 years, providing weak and non-swimmers wear an approved flotation device and stay within the non-swimmer line. The responsible person must be in the water and fully supervise the child/ren at all times.
