A reminder of our First Aid procedure



If your child is feeling unwell whilst at school, they should follow these steps:

Tell the class teacher. They will contact first aid via email.

Wait for first aid to come to the lesson.

The first aider will check how they are feeling and decide what to do next.

Sometimes the student can stay in school.

If the student is not 100% but still well enough to remain in school, the first aider may suggest:

A short rest

Drinking water

Having some food

The class teacher will keep an eye on the student

If the student still feels unwell, they should tell the teacher who will email the first aider to reassess.

It is important to remember that the student should not contact home themselves. This could lead to an unauthorised absence. School is a no-phone-zone and students should always follow the correct procedures.
