Mental Health Support Team (MHST)

At Montsaye we are pleased to be linked to the MHST who provide lower-level mental health practical support for our young people. This includes a range of 1-2-1 and group provisions for students as well as training for colleagues in the school to help us all recognise and support students who have mental health challenges.

They also work with the school beyond this provision to help us develop a mental health strategy and a crucial part of developing that strategy is getting the voice of our students, parents/carers and colleagues. The next step therefore in the MHST audit process is the completion of questionnaires by each of those groups of people. These will be done electronically, providing anonymised results straight to the MHST colleagues for analysis before providing the school overview of feedback.

As parents/carers of young people in our school your voice really does matter for us to get the most accurate picture of our provision so please do take the time to complete the questionnaire using the link below. The deadline for completion is Friday 20th March.
