## **SEND Drop-Ins**

Last academic year we held Inclusion drop-ins, including a dedicated Y6 transition evening, and they were a great success providing you with an opportunity to speak with members of our team.

#### **SEND Homework Club**

Our homework club will be continuing this academic year on a Monday and will be based in CS2. It is open to all students who would like some additional support or those who prefer to complete their homework at school.

All students are expected to complete homework, but reasonable adjustments are put in place for SEND students to support them further. This includes using the Sparx platform for some subjects where the algorithm adapts the content to the child specifically, focusing on time and effort put into homework rather than quantity, in addition to the homework club to support students too.
