

Sixth Form Entry Requirements

Students will enter the Sixth Form on one of three Pathways, based upon the number and type of Level 2 (GCSE) course results.

Pathway 1	Pathway 2	Pathway 3
Students with six GCSE grades 7 or above will be able to choose between three and four subjects.	Students with six GCSE grades 5 or above will be able to choose three subjects providing they meet any individual subject criteria	Students with six GCSE grades 4 or above must choose at least one level 3 vocational course (Health and Social Care, Sport and Physical, Dance, Music)

Subject Specific Entry Requirements

Students will have achieved at **least grade 5 at GCSE in any subject they intend to study at A Level.**
 Students may be able to study an A Level subject they did not take at GCSE, if they meet other entry criteria.
 Subjects with extra entry requirements are listed below.

Biology	Grade 6/6 in Combined Science, or Grade 6 in Biology and one other science. Grade 5 in Maths.
Chemistry	Grade 6/6 in Combined Science, or Grade 6 in Chemistry and one other science. Grade 5 in Maths.
Computer Science	Grade 6 in Computer Science GCSE
Dance	Grade 5 in Dance GCSE, or evidence of dance-related activities outside of school
Ethics and Philosophy	You need GCSE grade 5 or above in Ethics and Philosophy, although students with a grade 5 in both English and History will be considered.
French	Grade 6 in French GCSE
Maths	Grade 6 in Maths GCSE
Music	While it may help to have a GCSE in Music (Grade 5 or above) it is not a prerequisite. You should, however, be able to play an instrument or sing to a good standard
PE	Grade 5 in PE GCSE. Please note 15% of the course is practical in a sporting activity or coaching.
Physics	Grade 6/6 in Combined Science, or Grade 6 in Physics and one other science. Grade 5 in Maths
Psychology	Grade 4 in Maths GCSE Three GCSE's at grade 6 or above
